Old Business

Department Capital Plan - A. Gawel asked if any EC members have comments or edits to submit them asap. **Grease Trap -** in progress - might be installed as soon as this Wednesday.

Doctor Office Department Physicals - A. Gawel reported a few members do not have insurance that will cover them for a physician evaluation for the medical clearance questionnaire. He contacted Concentra regarding medical clearance for SCBA fit testing, N95 fit testing. Because the Town of Kent uses CIRMA, KVFD qualifies for discount pricing (attached). He is recommending an immediate expenditure to enable these uninsured members be able to go to Concentra to have this testing done.

Bingo

Caralee presented a budget (attached) to bring Bingo back to the department and hold it in the back building. She reported that in the past we used to make \$50,000 with Bingo. If we used the back building, the tables could stay up, there would be no need for attorneys, renters, and little overhead beyond bringing up the restrooms to ADA standards (if necessary) and apply for a change in use. She suggests we hold Bingo every Sunday. She also suggested Emergency Management could be housed there when not in use for Bingo, instead of using the meeting room. The current renter could stay in the space he currently uses. Questions included what other Bingo games were making, if there were going to be enough members to work, would there be concessions (yes there would be concessions). Alan would like Caralee to inquire the other Bingo games bring in, also would like to see a roster of people who have committed to working and how much time

they could commit, as well as confirmation from building official, fire marshal and zoning on what if any work/permitting that must be done in order to start Bingo.
